Annual Report for the Academic Year 2018 – 19

Dr. Umayal Ramanathan College for Women is dedicated to creating a positive impact on the lives of our students and the community. This annual report reflects our efforts to achieve this goal through academic excellence, holistic development, and strategic partnerships. We invite you to explore the achievements and milestones of the 2018-2019 academic year.

The academic year 2018-2019 marked a significant milestone for Dr. Umayal Ramanathan College for Women. This report provides a comprehensive overview of the institution's achievements, challenges, and future aspirations. It highlights our commitment to academic excellence, student welfare, and community engagement.

The college commenced the academic year on June 18th with a fresh intake of 554 students across 17 diverse disciplines. To enhance student learning, 13 value-added courses were introduced, benefiting 988 students. A robust mentor-mentee system was implemented to provide students with personalized guidance and support.

Practical learning was emphasized through internships, fieldwork, and project-based learning. 177 students gained valuable industry exposure and hands-on experience. Recognizing the financial challenges faced by students, the college awarded scholarships worth Rs. 16,67,695/- to 1130 students and 54 students benefiting from government scholarships amounting to Rs. 3,83,350. Additionally, 964 students received career guidance and support to prepare for competitive examinations. The college invested in providing a conducive learning environment with well-equipped classrooms, computer labs, and a comprehensive library.

The college boasts a faculty of 69 members, including 20 PhD holders and 10 SET/NET qualified educators, ensuring the delivery of high-quality education. To enhance faculty capabilities, 43 faculty members received financial support of Rs. 170100/- for attending national and international seminars, conferences, and memberships. A total of 62 faculty members and 8 non-teaching staff participated in faculty development programs.

Dr. Umayal Ramanathan College for Women fostered a lively campus life through a wide range of co-curricular and extracurricular activities. Students actively participated in 35 sports and cultural events, displaying their talents and representing the college at various platforms. To inculcate a sense of social responsibility, the college organized 14 outreach programs.

The institution ranked academic excellence and research by conducting 5 workshops, seminars, and conferences on topics such as research methodology, intellectual property rights, and entrepreneurship.

The college recorded a 93.11% success rate in the final examinations with 441 students clearing the exams out of 476. Demonstrating the institution's commitment to student employability, 126 students secured placements in various companies and 71 students progressed to higher education, showcasing the college's role in shaping future leaders.

To strengthen industry linkages and enhance academic partnerships, the college signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Voice Training and Research Private Limited, Madurai and conducted Certificate Course on TOEFL and Communication Skills.
