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Annual Report for the Academic Year 2019 - 2020

Dr. Umayal Ramanathan College for Women is committed to shaping the future leaders of tomorrow. This annual report portrays our efforts to create a dynamic and inspiring learning environment. It highlights the initiatives undertaken to empower our students, strengthen our academic programs, and contribute to societal progress.

Dr. Umayal Ramanathan College for Women marked a significant milestone in the academic year 2019-2020 in its journey. The institution demonstrated a strong commitment to holistic student development, academic excellence, and industry collaboration, resulting in substantial progress across various domains.

The college commenced the academic year with a fresh intake of 591 students across 20 diverse disciplines. To enhance the academic experience, 12 value-added courses were introduced, benefiting 801 students. A robust mentorship program was implemented to provide personalized guidance and support to all students.

To bridge the gap between academia and industry, 190 students were provided with practical learning opportunities through internships and projects. Recognizing the financial challenges faced by students, the college awarded scholarships worth Rs. 14,36,500/- to 1180 students. Additionally, government scholarships totaling Rs. 3,40,130/- were awarded to 49 students. To prepare students for competitive examinations, comprehensive career guidance and support were offered to 1639 students.

The college boasts a highly qualified faculty of 64 members, including 27 PhD holders and 12 SET/NET qualified educators. To enhance teaching-learning processes, the college invested in providing a conducive learning environment with well-equipped classrooms, computer labs, and a comprehensive library.

The institution prioritized academic excellence and research by conducting 11 workshops, seminars, and conferences on topics such as research methodology, intellectual property rights, and entrepreneurship. To foster a culture of research, the college provided financial support of Rs. 1,72,800 to 40 faculty members for attending conferences and workshops. Furthermore, faculty members received research grants worth Rs. 1.60 lakhs from non-government agencies.

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To ensure continuous professional development, 56 faculty members and 9 non-teaching staff underwent Faculty Development Programmes (FDP).

The college fostered a lively campus life through a wide range of co-curricular and extracurricular activities. Students actively participated in 41 sports and cultural events, with 6 students winning prizes at state and national levels. To inculcate a sense of social responsibility, the college organized 12 outreach programs through NSS, RSP, and YRC.

The college achieved a remarkable pass percentage of 99.63% with 542 students clearing the final examinations out of 544. Demonstrating its commitment to student employability, the college secured placements for 119 students. Moreover, 182 students progressed to higher education.

To strengthen industry linkages and enhance academic partnerships, the college signed 3 Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) and established 3 collaborative agreements.

The academic year 2019-2020 was marked by significant achievements to Dr. Umayal Ramanathan College for Women. The institution's unwavering commitment to student success, faculty development, and industry partnerships has positioned it as a leading institution in women's education.
