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Annual Report for the Academic Year 2020 - 2021

The academic year 2020-2021 witnessed substantial progress at Dr. Umayal Ramanathan College for Women. This annual report presents an overview of our key performance indicators, highlighting achievements in student outcomes, faculty development, infrastructure, and community engagement.


The academic year 2020-2021 began on 8th August with the enrollment of 601 new students across 20 diverse disciplines, reflecting the institution's broad academic offerings. To further enhance the educational experience, the college introduced 26 value-added courses, which positively influenced 1208 students. A comprehensive mentorship program, designed to offer personalized guidance and support to all students was implemented.

The college made significant strides in bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application. 190 students participated in internships and project-based learning opportunities, gaining valuable real-world experience. To address financial constraints, the college awarded scholarships amounting to Rs. 12,08,350/- to 1087 students. Additionally, government scholarships totaling Rs. 3,46,900/- were granted to 57 students. The college also supported 1439 students with extensive career guidance and preparation for competitive exams.

The faculty, consisting of 67 highly qualified members, including 29 with PhDs and 14 who are SET/NET qualified, played a crucial role in the institution's success. To bolster the teaching-learning environment, the college invested in state-of-the-art classrooms, well-equipped computer labs, and a comprehensive library.

In the pursuit of academic excellence and research, the college organized 8 workshops, seminars, and conferences on various relevant topics such as research methodology, intellectual property rights, and entrepreneurship. Financial support totaling Rs. 1,33,970/- was provided to 26 faculty members to attend these events, fostering a culture of research and continuous learning.

Professional development was a priority, with 50 faculty members and 14 non-teaching staff participating in Faculty Development Programmes (FDP). The college also promoted a vibrant campus life through active participation in 19 sports and cultural events. In terms of social responsibility, the institution organized 10 outreach programs via the NSS, RSP, and YRC.

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Academically, the college achieved an impressive pass percentage of 99.63%, with 529 students out of 531 successfully completing their final examinations. Demonstrating its commitment to employability, the college facilitated placements for 107 students and supported 232 students in pursuing higher education.

To strengthen industry connections and enhance academic partnerships, the college signed 6 Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) and established 2 collaborative agreements.

Overall, the academic year 2020-2021 marked a period of remarkable achievements for Dr. Umayal Ramanathan College for Women. The institution's steadfast focus on student success, faculty development, and industry engagement has established it as a leading institution in women's education.
