## Annual Report for the Academic Year 2021 - 22

The academic year 2021-2022 marked a period of significant growth and development for Dr. Umayal Ramanathan College for Women. The academic year 2021-2022 marked a significant milestone for Dr. Umayal Ramanathan College for Women. With a focus on holistic student development, academic excellence, and industry collaboration, the institution achieved substantial progress in various spheres.

The college commenced the academic year with a fresh intake of 512 students across 21 diverse disciplines. To enhance student learning, 23 value-added courses were introduced, benefiting a total of 891 students. The institution implemented a robust mentor-mentee system to provide students with personalized guidance and support.

Practical learning was emphasized through internships, fieldwork, and project-based learning. 209 students gained valuable industry exposure and hands-on experience. Recognizing the financial challenges faced by students, the college awarded scholarships worth Rs. 19,46,100 to 1075 students. Additionally, 1172 students received career guidance and support to prepare for competitive examinations.

The institution prioritized academic excellence and research by conducting 17 workshops, seminars, and conferences on topics such as research methodology, intellectual property rights, and entrepreneurship. Faculty development was a key focus, with 48 faculty members and 8 non-teaching staff undergoing training programs. To encourage research, the college provided financial support of Rs. 3,05,800/- to 63 faculty members for attending conferences and workshops. The collective efforts of the faculty resulted in securing Rs. 2.30 lakhs in research grants and publishing 7 research papers and 7 book chapters.

Out of 550 students who appeared for the final exams, 539 passed successfully and the college achieved a remarkable pass percentage of 98.7% in the final examinations. Demonstrating the institution's commitment to student employability, 136 students secured placements in various companies. Moreover, 241 students progressed to higher education, highlighting the college's role in shaping future leaders.

To strengthen industry linkages and enhance academic partnerships, the college signed 6 Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) with leading industries and institutions. Additionally, 2 collaborative agreements were established to facilitate knowledge exchange and resource sharing.
