 - a) Those who have not studied Tamil up to XII standard and taken a Non-Tamil language under Part I shall take Tamil comprising of two courses.
- b) Those who have studied Tamil up to XII standard and taken a Non-Tamil language under Part I shall take Advanced Tamil comprising of two courses.
- c) Others can take Communicative English and Effective Employability Skills
 - ii) Skill Based Subjects (SBS),
 - iii) Value Education & iv) Environmental Studies

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Separate application forms have to be submitted for choice of Major Subjects.
- The last date for the receipt of completed application form is the 10th working day from the date of publication of the results of the qualifying examinations (Tamilnadu +2 Examinations for U.G. Courses) and 15 days for PG courses.
- 3. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
- Admission for the entire course is based on merit under counseling method and personal interview by the selection committee of the college.
- 5. The provisionally selected candidate will be intimated by SMS to the mobile number.
- 6. The list of selected candidates will be put up on the college notice board
- 7. Applicants who receive such communication must appear before the Principal with parent or guardian and must be ready to pay fees on the date indicated therein and should produce the following certificates when the admission is confirmed by the Principal. Failure to pay the fees on the date or to produce the following necessary certificates in original will entail in the forfeiture of the seat.
 - i. Higher Secondary or Equivalent / Degree Mark Sheets
 - ii. Transfer certificate and Conduct certificate
 - iii. Community certificate in the case of MBC/OBC/DNC/BC/SC/ST or at least a temporary certificate duly attested by Gazetted Officer (an officer of the Revenue Department not lower in rank than Deputy Tahsildar) valid for a year from the date of issue.
 - iv. Income Certificate
 - v. Aadhaar Card
 - vi. Two recent passport size photos
 - vii. Certificate of proof for the differently-abled

- 8. Once a student is admitted to a group no further change of group will be considered
- Candidate and her parent/guardian should submit a declaration in the prescribed form at the time of admission. The original certificates submitted at the time of admission will be returned only after the completion of the course.
- After admission if any student wishes to discontinue the course she shall pay the entire fees payable for the complete course of study before being relieved from the college (3 years for UG, 2 years for PG).
- If the candidate fails to attend the counseling, the allotted seat will be given to the next person on merit basis.

NOTE

- The name of the candidate and date of birth should be identical in all the original certificates. No correction or overwriting is permitted without attestation/signature of the proper authority.
- ii. Candidates are informed that the original certificates produced at the time of admission will not be returned under any circumstance in the middle of their studies in the college. They are requested to take True copies / Photostat Copies of all certificates including examination marks duly attested by a Gazetted Officer before submitting to the College. No requests for return of certificates will be entertained during the middle of the course.
- iii. The acceptance of application does not carry any guarantee for admission into courses of study in the college.
- Application for extension of time for payment of fees will neither be acknowledged nor entertained.
- v. The candidates of the Central Schools, Kendriya Vidyalaya etc. seeking admission are informed that their T.C.'s should be counter signed by the Inspection Officer of the Institution or by the

Regional Director of Central Board of Secondary Education.

FEES STRUCTURE

- The actual amount of fees payable will be intimated at the time of admission.
- Fees must be paid on or before 5th June and 5th December for every odd semester and even semester respectively.
- 3. Fees should be paid either by cash or through DD at Alagappa trust office directly.
- 4. Delay in payment of term fees will invite a fine of Rs.200/-.
- The management reserves the right to modify the fees structure without prior notification.
- 6. Payment of fees in installment is not permitted.
- 7. Fees once paid by the student will not be refunded under any circumstance.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Students must be regular and punctual in coming to the college and classes.
- 2. Students should not leave the college premises during class hours without the permission of the competent authority.
- Abstaining from classes without prior permissions is a breach of discipline and such absence should be avoided.
- The Management reserves the right to modify the class timings and schedule.
- 5. The decision of the Principal is final and binding in all matters pertaining to the institution.
- 6. Wearing identity card is compulsory.
- 7. Usage of mobile phone is prohibited.
- 8. Students are not permitted to participate in fashion shows, stage shows, modeling or talk shows and any other public performance without prior permission of the Principal.
- Ragging is totally banned and is punishable as per the Government order. The institution is having the right to expel any student who engages in the activity of ragging.
- The admitted students should obey the rules and regulations in force, and the college reserves the right to dismiss a student in case of disobedience.
- 11. Students will be responsible for all the equipments entrusted to them.
- The college is not responsible for any accident to the students due to careless handling of equipment/chemicals.

DRESSCODE

- Wearing tight and short dresses in campus is strictly prohibited.
- Students are allowed to wear half-sarees, sarees or churidar with duppatta only.

EXAMINATION

For all the UG and PG courses, examination will be conducted at the end of each semester under CBCS pattern. The two components of evaluation are Continuous Internal Assessment and End Semester University Examination which carry 25 and 75 marks respectively. Students have to attend the Internal Assessment compulsorily. 80% attendance per semester is insisted upon for taking the University Examinations.
